I am a tourist and have purchased goods here which I am taking out of the country, can I claim the VAT back and what is the procedure for this?

The Qualifying Purchaser / Tourist must be a Non South African citizen in possession of a passport and an invoice.

Upon arrival at the port he / she must proceed to the Vat Refund Administrator (VRA) who must verify the physical goods against the description of goods on the invoice.

If less than the VRA limit, which presently is R3000, the refund should be issued immediately.

If more, the claim must be submitted to VRA Head Office. In the case of goods which are heavy to be carried as hand luggage, such goods must be checked by Customs who will endorse and date stamp the invoice which must be produced to VRA for refund claim purposes.
