REGISTRATION FOR SOUTH AFRICA GENERAL ELECTIONS 2024

To be able to vote in the South African general elections, you must register as a voter. Once you've registered, your name will be added to the South African voter's roll. It is advisable to check and ensure that your name indeed appears on the SA voter's roll.

For South African citizens in Belgium and Luxembourg, the Embassy in Brussels will have a voter registration weekend on 27 and 28 January 2024 (08h00 – 17h00).
