

South African National Elections 2024

Voting Station Brussels

(South African Embassy, Rue Montoyer 17-19, 1000 Brussels)

Date: Saturday, 18th May 2024 **Time:** 07h00 until 19h00.



Voting Process:

Stage 1

Pre-screening of voter against the voter's roll and check South African ID document / card.

Stage 2

Voter to queue to enter voting station (Elderly, disabled, or pregnant persons will be referred to the front of the queue)

Stage 3

Voter to be screened and directed to the voting room via staircase or lift if need be (elderly, disabled, pregnant persons - wheel chairs, prams etc)

Stage 4

Voter to be received at the voting room.

Stage 5

Process for voter in voting room

Table 1 - Confirm ID and voter information on voter's roll.

Table 2 – mark voter's left thumb with the applicable ink marker.

Table 3 - voter to receive ballot paper and envelopes.

Table 4 – voter to cast vote at ballot compartment / booth.

Table 5 – voter to deposit envelope (ballot) in ballot box.

Voter directed to exit voting station.

Party agents must be in possession of an IEC appointment letter (VEC 9 form) as well as a valid SA ID/TIC/ smartcard. Party agents should introduce themselves to the Special Voting Officer a day before voting day.

Observers must be accredited with the Electoral Commission of South Africa
